About the Program

Launched in 2021, DiLSeY is a flagship initiative designed to spread awareness on digital safety. The program empowers volunteers from IT, education, and communities to sensitize youth, students, and citizens about cyber threats and safe online practices.

Since its launch, DiLSeY has trained 2 batches of volunteers, delivered 350+ awareness sessions, and reached 2.5 million people, effectively building grassroots digital awareness and empowering citizens as online safety ambassadors.
