## Launch of Stay Safe Portal

SafeStay is a digital portal designed to enhance the Safety of women in Hostels and PG accommodations within the Cyberabad Commissionerate. The platform lists hostels that have been audited and verified based on the **10 Safety Commandments of the Cyberabad Police**, highlighting key safety features for residents and stakeholders. Currently, **1005 hostels** are verified on the portal, with a vision to scale up to **4000 hostels by June 2026**.
